CONCEPT OF HATE CRIMES

- "criminal offences committed with a bias motive" (OSCE MC.DEC/9/09)
 ≠ discrimination
 ≠ hate motivated incident
 ≠ hate speech
- examples
 - swastika painted on the wall of synagogue
 - gay couple threatened with violence on the street
 - asylum seeker assaulted while chanting racial slur
 - serial killing of Roma families

- "sense of reality"
- raise awareness and sense of urgency of the issue
- better understand the phenomenon
- help participants identify problems with police practice


